Pinnacle Ministries and Converge Great Lakes

Gary wears two hats, that of Pinnacle Ministries (working across denominations) and Executive Director of Church Strengthening for Converge Great Lakes. In both roles the calling is the same - "Healthy Pastors, Healthy Leaders, Leading Healthy and Effective Churches." Marie is a partner with Gary in his work at Pinnacle.

Pray as Gary addresses church health issues both here and in Japan. Currently Pinnacle is working on reformatting & republishing the Retool Kit Pathway in both English and Japanese in time for the 2023 7th Annual Congress on Japanese Evangelism. This is a major endeavor, requiring considerable fundraising (\$60,000?). He is also currently engaged in helping a number of churches with improving ministry impact.
